WHY:

Because we want...

- + to attract the interest for the world of research in general.
- + to bring the activities of the Roque de Los Muchachos to the local population.
- + to disseminate the scientific knowledge.
- + to inspire students to work in research.

WHO:

- + Almost every astronomer working at the Roque de Los Muchachos Observatory.
- + Every secondary school on La Palma.
- + The Canarian Council of Education and the local teachers.
- + The local authorities (provide funding for transport).



HOW:

1 astronomer ("the shepherd") leads a group of ~20 students:

- + gives a talk at the school: why astrophysics, distances, the light, the search for life, and questions, many questions...
- + guides a visit to the telescope where the astronomer works.
- + organises a workshop at the observatory where to learn about spectroscopy, the near-infrared, Sun observing.
- + and gives the possibility of extending the programme of activities.

RESULTS:

Every year, we reach...

- + 100% the local 16-year old students.
(a total of ~800 - total population of La Palma 80,000).
- + ~2 science teachers from every school.

and we engage...

- + 25 astronomers (~8 hours of dedication in total).
- + 5 telescopes can be visited.
- + 12 staff, from different institutions doing team-work.
