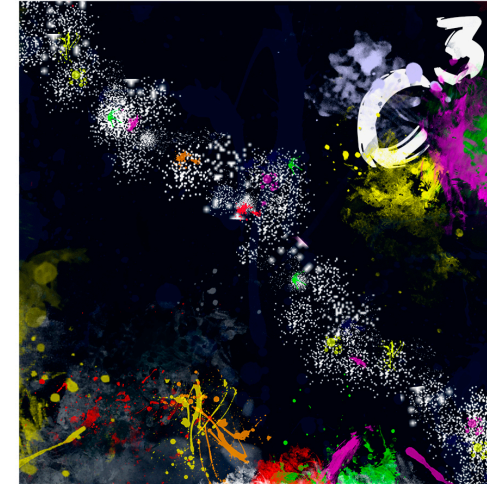

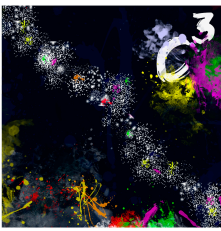

CULTURA CON C DE COSMOS

ABSTRACT: An interdisciplinary project to do Astronomy and Astrobiology outreach through art, music, literature, poetry... supported on the essence, experience and initiatives of numerous cultural entities based in Madrid. In parallel, to disseminate knowledge about their legacy and collections from the perspective of science observations.

GOALS



Contribute to break the traditional dichotomy “sciences vs. humanities” and promote passion for culture and knowledge in general

Bring science to society from unusual venues

Involve professionals from a great diversity of specialties to achieve the project goals (scientists, artists, musicians, science/art/history communicators, photographers, etc)

Collaborate with the participant cultural entities to promote the appreciation of their collections by the public from the perspective of scientific observations

Create synergies with some of these entities and set the roots for longer-term collaborations

Contribute to modify cultural referents and social models that are offered in different ways for girls and boys, with frequent biases that can influence negatively their future choice of degree

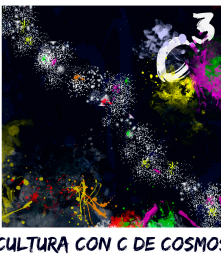

+40 entities involved (museums, foundations, universities, libraries, art galleries, etc)

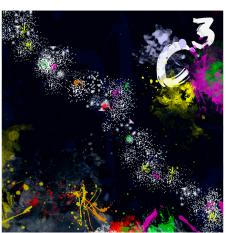
